- 4. What kinds of prayer do we find in the Bible? (question #233, pg 233)? (Hint: six types listed)
- 5. How does God answer our prayers (question #235)?
- 6. What is the Lord's Prayer (question #240)?
- 7. Read "The Introduction" to the the Lord's Prayer and meaning on the top of page 237. How does knowing God is your Father encourage you to pray?
- 8. In the same way that the Ten Commandments are broken into two tables (3 and 7), so the seven petitions of the Lord's Prayer are broken into two sections. Can you tell how these two sections are divided? What does each section focus on? (pgs 19-22).
